Junction City, KY-May 21, 2010- The American Sprint Car Tour was set to bring Sprint Car racing back to Ponderosa Speedway for the first time since 1996 on Friday evening, but Mother Nature had other plans as rains overnight would make the pit and parking absolutely soaked, forcing cancellation of the event on Friday May 21.

No make-up date has been set for this time, but if track officials and ASCT officials can work out a suitable date, a date will be announced at a later time.

Next up for Ponderosa Speedway will be a night of weekly racing series competition on Friday May 28. Three of the four weekly divisions will be in action as the Good Neighbor Pharmacy Super Late Models, Bob Allen Motor Mall Pro Late Models, and Clayton Homes UMP Modifieds will all be in competition at the 3/8 mile D-shaped red clay oval better known as "Kentucky's Baddest Bullring". The D&D Pallet Recyclers UMP Sportsman will be off on May 28, but will return to action on Friday June 4.

Ponderosa Speedway is located just off of 365 Phillips Lane on the Boyle/Lincoln County border, outside of Junction City, KY, just minutes from Danville, KY. Larry, Chad, and Sarah Yantz are the track promoters and present dirt track sports entertainment on Friday evenings from April through early October.
